PUBLIC COMMENT REQUEST PROCESS

The above-noticed meeting of the Board of Governors shall take place as follows:

Public Comment: Effective Immediately, all meetings of the Board of Governors (Board) will be held in person. The Board will resume the public comment procedures that were in place prior to the pandemic. **As a result, please be advised that Zoom public comments will no longer be accepted.** Members of the public seeking to comment on an agenda item or another topic within the jurisdiction of the Board of Governors will be given the opportunity to comment in advance or in-person at the location listed above. All comments will be limited to two minutes and the following policies:

- **Written:** You may email your comment request in advance to BoardComments@CCCCO.edu. In the email subject line, specify the item number associated with your comment. Persons seeking to address the Board on a topic not on the agenda must do so during the public forum item. At the top of your email, you may identify yourself or indicate that you choose to remain anonymous. All written public comments must be submitted by the end of business, **Wednesday, July 19, 2023**. Comments received by the deadline will be provided to the Board of Governors and made public.
- **In Person:** A request for comments must be submitted on the form provided by the Board Liaison. Persons seeking to address the Board on a topic not on the agenda must do so during the public forum item. All in-person comments must be submitted before the item concludes. The Board will announce your name in the order it was received.
 - The Board of Governors reserves the right to limit the total amount of time allocated for public comment on particular issues and for each individual speaker. (Gov. Code 11125.7.)
 - For members of the public utilizing a translator or other translating technology, the Chancellor's Office shall provide twice the allotted time to ensure that non-English speakers receive the same opportunity to directly address the Board. (Gov. Code 11125.7.)
