**RE: Report on California Community Colleges Nursing Educational Programs  
Multicriteria Selection Process for Fiscal Year 2021-22**

Dear Gov. Newsom:

Education Code section 78261.5 requires the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office to prepare and submit an annual report on 1) the participation, retention and completion rates in community college registered nursing programs of students admitted through a multicriteria screening process and 2) disaggregated by the age, gender, ethnicity and the language spoken at the home of those students.

A full review of the information provided to us by the colleges revealed gaps in the data required. For example, colleges do not report information on languages spoken by nursing students. The Chancellor's Office is working to resolve data interoperability that make it difficult to provide exact counts for what has been requested. This report combines data on students in their last year of nursing training with program-level data that allows for estimates of total student populations and demographics.

Table 3 shows colleges participating in a multicriteria screening process disaggregated by gender for FY2021-22.

- Note: Due to the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), the Chancellor’s Office and the California community colleges are required to take steps to protect the identity of students. This includes suppressing data in reports where there is a likelihood that someone might be able to draw an inference about individual students from the aggregated data. Because of this, the Chancellor’s Office has a policy to suppress data on student groups where the number of students represented is less than 20.

In addition to “direct data suppression,” sometimes “indirect data suppression” is required. This comes in circumstances where suppressing a single group allows for inferences to be drawn about that group anyway. For example, if a college has 70 nursing students, where 60 are female and 10 are male, the male group would be suppressed due to low numbers (10 is below the threshold of 20), but the female group would have to be suppressed as well, as reporting on both the aggregate and the female group could allow someone to calculate the relevant statistics for the male group.

In both cases of direct and indirect suppression, all student data is reported as “masked values.”
