SUBJECT: Intent to Submit an Application for the Career Technical Education -
Teacher Preparation Pipeline Grant.

The purpose of this memorandum is to solicit your interest in applying for the 2007-08 Career Technical Education - Teacher Preparation Pipeline Grant. Only districts/campuses which express an interest in applying will be sent the Request for Application.

The Chancellor's Office of the California Community Colleges is requesting applications from community college districts to help address the anticipated shortage of secondary and community college Career Technical Education (CTE) teachers. Grant recipients, in conjunction with high schools and baccalaureate-granting institutions, will identify, recruit, enroll, and retain students in courses designed to provide a pathway leading to a teaching career in one of today's CTE fields. The 2007-08 Governor's Budget appropriated \$2,000,000 for this purpose, which will allow for the funding of 6-20 projects from \$100,000 to \$350,000 each.
