Perkins IV Title I-C Advisory Memorandum

Continuation of SB 70 Career Technical Education Funds

California Department of Finance and legislative staff indicated a shared understanding that SB 70 CTE funds are not subject to the newly established categorical flexibility for selected state categorical programs. The construction of the budget revision and trailer bills left this in doubt. It appears that that this clarification may be accomplished through a technical budget correction as opposed to cleanup legislation. Given this clarification, districts should not treat these funds as subject to categorical flexibility.
