Issue

The California Community Colleges Chief Student Services Administrators Association has established a new scholarship award program to recognize students transitioning out of the community college system who have demonstrated outstanding leadership qualities at the campus, regional, and/or statewide level. The Chief Student Services Officer (CSSO) at each college was invited to nominate one outstanding student leader.
