ARCC Background

- ◆ Established in 2004 (AB 1417 Pacheco)
- ◆ First report: ARCC 2007 (March)
- ◆ Updated annually (4th report)
- ◆ Provides drafts for local review and seeks local response to data
- ◆ Legislative Analyst's Office and Department of Finance

ARCC Content

Systemwide data (not in Oct draft)

- Percentage of baccalaureate from the CCC
- Volume of transfer/transfer rate
- Annual numbers of vocational awards and credit basic skills improvements
- Top 25 CTE programs by total awards
- Income trends for graduates with CTE degrees or certificates
- Participation rates

ARCC Content

College-level data

- Student Progress & Achievement Rate
- At least 30 units, and Persistence Rates
- Vocational & Basic Skills Course Completion Rates
- ESL & Basic Skills Course Improvement
- Career Development & College Preparation Progress & Achievement Rate
- College Profile (demographics)

Changes from Last Year's Report

- ◆ Dropped earliest cohorts (from 2009 ARCC)
- ◆ Added most recent cohorts
- ◆ Table 1.10 (Ethnicity of Students) consolidated “other non-white” with “unknown/non-respondent”
- ◆ Peer groups for 2010 same as groups in 2009
- ◆ Limited participation rates to ages 18 – 65
- ◆ Added “Multirace” to Table 17

Why no new Peer Groups?

- ◆ Too much instability in the peer groups between annual ARCC reports
- ◆ Expect new peer groups because of data from the 2010 Census
- ◆ Completion of CB 21 recode project will motivate new peer groups as well

New with Jan/Feb Draft Report

- ◆ Jan. draft has systemwide indicators and peer grouping
- ◆ Data changes no longer possible
- ◆ Use Jan. draft to write self-assessment
 - Submit self-assessment via website
- ◆ Schools of continuing education must also submit a self-assessment

Why did my data change?

- ◆ New queries for all data
- ◆ Curriculum Reporting for the Community Colleges (CRCC) course recoding effort and CB 21 recode
- ◆ Student identifier (SB00) cleanup
- ◆ New methodology for National Student Clearinghouse match

Why did my data change?

- ◆ “DR” code added to SX04 Enrollment-Grade (part of the CRCC project)
 - DR = Drop after first census date
 - Memo of 10/12/06
 - Implemented in Summer 2007
 - Possibly affects denominators for Vocational and Basic Skills Course Completion Rates; could affect rates

Tips for Reviewing Report

- ◆ Don't wait. Start your review and self-assessment
- ◆ Read the introductory report sections
- ◆ Concentrate on data for your college
- ◆ See Appendix A Intro to learn about peer grouping for this year
- ◆ See Appendix B for methodology
- ◆ Use the resources on ARCC website

- ◆ College self-assessment is due on March 4, 2010, by 5:00 p.m.
- ◆ Board of Trustee Interaction for the **2009** report is due by March 15, 2010.
- ◆ 2010 ARCC Report released by Mar. 31, 2010.
