**ISSUE:** This item requests recognition of Compton College as an accredited college within the California Community College system.

**BACKGROUND:** In June of 2005, the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges (ACCJC) terminated the accreditation of Compton College. In 2006, the Board of Governors approved the facilities of Compton College as an off-campus educational center of the El Camino Community College District. Through the partnership between the El Camino and Compton Community College Districts, students at the El Camino College Compton Center have continued to receive transferable and degree-applicable educational opportunities in the Compton community. On June 7, 2017, the ACCJC granted initial accreditation status to Compton College. This item requests that the Board of Governors recognize Compton College as an accredited college within the California Community College system.

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board of Governors adopt the attached Resolution No. 2017-02, recognizing Compton College as an accredited college within the California Community College system.
