

## ATTACHMENT 2

### SUMMARY AND ANALYSIS OF PROPOSED REVISIONS TO TITLE 5 REGULATIONS: OF ACADEMIC RECORD SYMBOLS AND GRADE POINT AVERAGE – § 55023 WITHDRAWAL – § 55024

#### General changes

A substantive change proposing the Excused Withdrawal (EW) non-evaluative symbol to permit a student to withdraw from a course for reasons beyond their control. The EW cannot be counted toward the permitted number of withdrawals nor as an enrollment attempt.

#### Detail

##### Subdivision 55023(e)

Subdivision 55023(e) allows for the EW symbol.

##### Section 55024(d)(3)

Subdivision 55024(d)(3) clarifies that the Military Withdrawal cannot be counted as an enrollment attempt.

##### Subdivision 55024(e)

Subdivision 55024(e) adds that a governing board of a district shall adopt an EW procedure if they provide a withdrawal policy generally.

##### Subdivision 55024(e)(1)

Subdivision 55024(e)(1) allows for the EW non-evaluative symbol to be used when a student must withdraw from a course for reasons beyond their control.

##### Subdivision 55024(e)(2)

Subdivision 55024(e)(2) prohibits the EW from being counted in progress probation and dismissal calculations.

##### Subdivision 55024(e)(3)

Subdivision 55024(e)(3) adds and clarifies that the EW cannot be counted toward the permitted number of withdrawals nor as an enrollment attempt.

##### Subdivision 55024(e)(4)

Subdivision 55024(e)(4) adds and clarifies that the EW cannot be replaced with an FW grade.

##### Subdivision 55024(f)

This is a non-substantive change provision that existed as prior section 55024(e).
