2. The data are used for many purposes including: Scorecard, Salary Surfer, Gainful Employment, SB70 CSAC and IPEDS
3. AAT or AST awards are reported using:
 - A(for A.A.)and S(for A.S.) code in SP02(Program-Award)
 - SP04 (Program-Unique-Code) for the AAT or AST program
4. Calendar data for Academic Year 2013-2014 are now due.

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Student Success Data File

1. SB 1456 Implementation MIS Revision and New Allocation Formula Workgroup
2. The Matriculation Program is now known as the Student Success and Support Program
3. The workgroup was “charged” with responsibility of reviewing all the MIS Matriculation data elements and developing a new funding formula.



Student Success Data File

1. New Data File – SS Student Success Data File
2. Optional 2013-14 – Mandatory 2014-15
3. The current Matriculation Data file (SM) will continue to be collected thru academic year 2013-14. The Matriculation Data file (SM) will no longer be collected beginning Summer 2014.
4. New Data File will be posted to the web very soon
5. MIS will have breakout sessions at the Student Success and Support Program Implementation Summit in Sacramento on September 23-24, 2013
6. MIS will be offering a follow-up webinar in October 2013 with more detailed discussion on the individual SS data elements.

Additional Data Quality Checks:

1. Reject the submission if: for SS01 Student-Educational-Goal
More than 25% of credit, non-special admit students, have a value of “M” (undecided on goal)
2. Reject the submission if: for SS02 Student-Course-of-Study
More than 35% of credit, non-special admit students, have a value of “YYYYYY” (student is exempt)
and/or
More than 45% of credit, non-special admit students, have a value of “000000”(no course of study)



SB14 – Student Educational Goal

Beginning Summer 2014 the SB14 (Student-Educational-Goal) data element will no longer accept “Obtain a 2-year vocational degree without transfer - D” as a valid field value.

This element identifies the student’s principal educational goal. The goal is not updated unless the student’s enrollment lapses for at least an academic year.
