CALIFORNIA COMMUNITY COLLEGES

TELECOMMUNICATIONS AND TECHNOLOGY INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM (CCC TECHNOLOGY CENTER) GRANT

Provision G of Section II of the RFA, "Telecommunications and Technology Infrastructure Program CCC Technology Center", is revised to read as follows:

- 1. Conduct a preliminary review of the applications to determine if they are in compliance with the RFA Specification; application format; required signatures; and the number of copies.
- 2. A panel of three readers consisting of Chancellor's Office staff and/or non-Chancellor's Office shall be assembled to score and rank the applications to determine eligibility. Readers shall use the same evaluation criteria for all applications. All applicants achieving at least 75 points on their evaluations are eligible for funding. Application scores are ranked in descending order and funds are disbursed to the number of projects pursuant to the RFA Specification, until all funds are allocated. An eligible score of 75 points does not guarantee a grant award. However, the eligible but non-awarded applicant(s) are placed on an eligible-not funded list and may be awarded grants in the future, should funds become available.
- 3. If the total amount of funds requested by applicants pursuant to any individual RFA Specification cannot be funded by the amount of funds available hereunder, assemble three readers from within and outside the Chancellor's Office to score and rank the applications in order of eligibility. All applicants achieving at least 75 points on their application evaluations are eligible for funding. An eligible score of 75 points does not guarantee a grant award. Application scores are ranked in descending order and funds are disbursed in the same manner until all funds are allocated.

4. Prepare and post notice of intent to award grants under each respective RFA Specification. This notice will include the scoring and ranking results of all applications received.

5. If there are any funds remaining under any RFA Specification in which grants have been awarded to all of the eligible applicants, the Chancellor's Office may elect to award the remaining funds under other RFA Specification, as long as the awards are made in accordance with the AF and AFP lists already established hereunder and their purpose is consistent with the funding source. Staff also reserves the right to issue an addendum to the original RFA that will extend the deadline for the receipt of applications pursuant to any RFA Specification with funds still available.
