Questions:

1. If the stipulated Matching fund is 5% shouldn't the Indirect be the same amount? The RFA stipulates the Matching Fund as 5% and the Indirect at 4%
 - The Match Fund in the RFA is designed to ensure the grantee maintains a stake in the operation and success of the grant.
2. Must the RFA respondent provide a transition plan if the awardee remains the same?
 - Inclusion of a transition plan is a scored item in the RFA response. All respondents should provide a transition plan in the response to the request for application.
3. Can the CO provide a list of solicitation of interest respondents not on the call to those who were?
 - The Chancellor's Office does not provide copies of responses to the Solicitation of Interest until the intent to award is posted for an RFA.
