1. Welcome and Attendance

2. Icebreaker Activity

Committee Members shared their highlights for the year
3. Approval of Agenda (attachment) Osea/Stewart
4. Approval of Minutes (attachment): May 20, 2022 Stewart/Osea
5. Regulation Changes: Field Feedback & Revisions
 - a. Work Experience Education
 - i. Review & discuss feedback received to date
 1. Incorporation of equity and economically disadvantaged students. Met with Brook Oliver for background on Work Experience. Suggestion to add in definition and opportunities for paid employment for low incomes students.
 2. Feedback on simplify administrative processes (records/documents/signatures) and the request for fewer regulations for employers. 5C agreed that the current regulations likely exist to provide colleges' liability coverage and should be retained. CCCCCO will concur with legal on what needs to be included.
 3. Inclusion of Equity in regulations. Add requirement for "disaggregated data" for those completing work experience. Add language on underrepresented students and socio-economic status.
 4. Add alignment of COR to regulations under student educational agreement with employer.
 5. COCI Changes: Add noncredit category. Embedded in course code? Validation in field over 54 for 60 units in regulation. Should we change to 54 hours rather than 60, 55253a.1. Make the same as all other credit hour calculations. Recommended change to align to all other credit hours. Top Code in COCI need to be able to add a general top

- code. Perhaps take out limit on COCI that the field needs to be vocational.
- 6. Streamlining the reporting structures (ask legal what is required).
- 7. Questions on how work experience relates to work study.
- 8. Discussion on unit limits. What is the definition of an enrollment period.
- 9. Discussion on taking out lifetime ban and expand number for total available for enrollment period. CCCCCO will follow up on historical reason and addressing any potential financial aid and transfer implications.
- 10. Hours: Ed Code 51760.3 has 40 hours and 10 hours per enrollment period. Aligned to K-12 Ed Code.
- 11. Title 5 5801b address limit on number of students per faculty advisor. Should this be a local decision? Perhaps take it out of regulation and make it a local decision.

- i. Determine desired revisions

- 1. How can we add background on how to define DEI in the entire COR.
- 2. Do we need a specific element in the COR.
- 3. Streamline Standards for Course Approval. Don't separate out by course type.
- 4. Recommendation Curriculum Committee should have documented procedures and add to yearly certification processes.
- 5. Focus on how to support the curriculum committee.
- 6. Could change language in D to how used through out the COR. Could be a local decision over a regulation. Consensus was to remove sections D and E.
- 7. Reviewed/Revise language on Standards for Course Approval. Including adding section on accessibility.

6. 2021-2022 5C Year in Review

- 2) Need to address changes from DEI and COR (55002). Changes Impact other Title 5 sections 55130 and 55150 (addresses credit and noncredit).

Groups brought back recommendations for the next 5C Committee

- Reimagining PCAH

- a. See credit and noncredit combined so not distinct and repetitive. Note only specific differences.
- b. Additional streamlining for new CTE and short term vocational (not PCAH but needed).
- c. Need to incorporate the DEIA in Standards of Approval. Local process requirements (Address new regulations).
- d. Support Curriculum Committees with Professional Development (DEIA in the COR).
- e. Reduce Title 5 regulations (streamlined). Appendix with full text of Title 5 regulations.
- f. Living document with edit date (like attendance model).
- g. Change name (Curriculum Handbook of California Community Colleges).
- h. Need a crosswalk to support changes for submissions.

 - a. Work with groups to define HyFlex (D-TACC, CVC-OEI).
 - b. Landscape Analysis of Hyflex definitions.
 - c. What regulations need to be changed.
