The Chancellor's Office is seeking individuals, from a variety of backgrounds, to read and score Mathematics, Engineering, Science Achievement (MESA) applications.

The MESA program will allocate funding for up to thirty-five MESA programs in California. MESA programs provide academic and support services for economically disadvantaged students majoring in calculus-based fields who seek to transfer to four-year colleges and universities. The application review period will be July 20-27, 2017. Participants will be provided with instructions and application scoring sheets, as they are able to read and score the applications remotely. Each reader will review approximately 5-7 MESA applications, although the total number of applications will not be known until the submission deadline of 5:00 pm on July 14, 2017.
