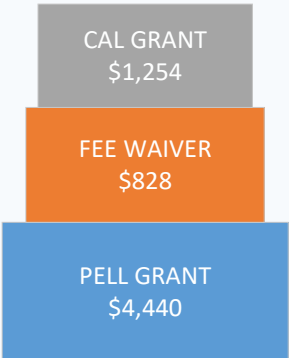


Typical financial aid benefits for California Community College students

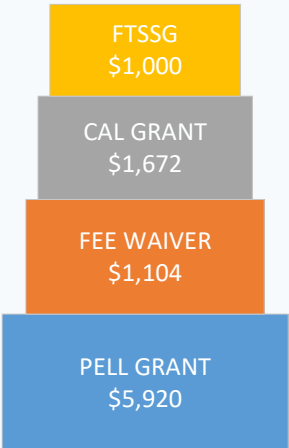

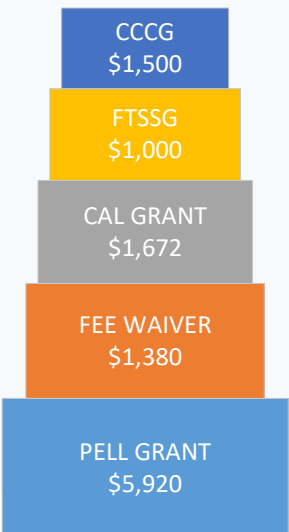
