The California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office is pleased to announce the availability of a grant award to support the continuation of the HBCU Transfer Agreement Project. This grant is a five-year award funded with Proposition 98 money at \$581,000 per fiscal year, for a total of \$2,905,000. One grant award is available.

This grant's overarching objective is to provide for additional transfer pathways and improved outcomes for Black/African American students, and is closely aligned with the Board of Governors adopted Vision for Success goals to increase transfer and reduce equity gaps. The project, initiated in 2013, is currently administered by the El Camino CCD and has formal transfer agreements with 40 of the 101 HBCUs throughout the country.

An information session is scheduled for January 11, 2021 to discuss the RFA details and provide an opportunity to ask questions regarding the RFA.
