California Apprenticeship Initiative, New and Innovative Grants

- Grants to support the creation of pre-apprenticeship and apprenticeship programs in non-traditional, emerging, and innovative sectors or areas in which apprenticeship training is not fully established or does not exist.
- \$57 Million available
- Funding Period: July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2026
- Application Due Date: December 16, 2022
 - Award notification: February 3, 2023
- One entity can submit any number of applications
- A program can only be included in one application and cannot be supported by two grants simultaneously
 - If multiple entities are connected to one program, the Lead LEA should submit a grant application.

- Multiple grant types that address specific outcomes
 - Including planning and program expansion
- Larger grant awards
- Labor market data informed decisions
- Rolling application windows
- Student Support Services



Multiple Grant Types

- Program Planning
- Program Implementation
- Program Expansion





Program Planning Grant

1. Purpose

- a. Up to 1-year grant term
- b. Up to \$120,000 per award
- c. 80% advance payment, 20% contingent
- d. Develop a plan to create and register new programs with DAS

2. Eligible Entities

a. CCs - CCDs - RCs - COEs - K12LEAs - ROCPs

3. Outcomes

- a. Obtain DAS registration
- b. Identify anticipated program participants
 - a. For Apprenticeship Programs: obtain employer MOUs
- c. Identify wages



Program Implementation Grant

1. Purpose

- a. Up to 3-year grant term
- b. Up to \$1,500,000 per award
- c. 30% advance, 70% quarterly invoice
- d. Start-up a registered DAS preapprenticeship or apprenticeship program.

2. Eligible Entities

a. CCDs - COEs - K12 LEAs

3. Outcomes

- a. 1 apprentice/\$15,000; 1 preapprentice/\$2,500
- b. 80% complete
- c. Living wages (Apprentices)
- d. Sustainability plan
- e. Student Services



Program Expansion Grant

1. Purpose

- a. Up to 2-year grant term
- b. Up to \$1,000,000 per award
- c. 30% advance, 70% quarterly invoice
- d. Expand existing program capacity

2. Eligible Entities

a. CCDs – COEs – K12 LEAs

3. Outcomes

- a. 1 apprentice/\$15,000
- b. Living wages
- c. Sustainability plan
- d. Student Services



Application Scoring

- RFA Requirements (75/80 Points)
 - Planning Grants = 80 to prioritize planning and growth
 - Answer all questions in NOVA application
 - Provide all supporting documents requested in NOVA application
- Labor Market Demand (15/20 Points)
 - Planning Grants = 20 points to make up for no cost score
 - Adjusted proportion of labor market demand multiplied by available points
- Cost (10 Points)
 - 1 additional point per \$1,000 less per apprentice
 - 1 additional point per \$250 less per pre-apprentice



Application Windows

- The Chancellor's Office will use this same RFA for all of FY22-23, opening applications as needed.
 - Additional application windows and deadlines will be announced through ESLEI MEMOs
 - As short as 1-month windows
 - All funds available each round



Reporting Schedule

- January 15, 2024
 - 1st report due: expenditures and outcomes between July 1, 2023 and December 31, 2023
- August 15, 2024
 - 2nd report due: expenditures and outcomes between July 1, 2023 and June 30, 2024
- January 15, 2025
 - 3rd report due: expenditures and outcomes between July 1, 2023 and December 31, 2024
- August 15, 2025
 - 4th report due: expenditures and outcomes between July 1, 2023 and June 30, 2025
- January 15, 2026
 - 5th report due: expenditures and outcomes between July 1, 2023 and December 31, 2025
- August 15, 2026
 - Final report due: expenditures and outcomes between July 1, 2023 and June 30, 2026



Other Information

- RFA Questions due December 2, 2022
- FAQ posted ASAP and will be updated on Mondays
- Award appeal deadline is February 10, 2023
- Invoicing available quarterly
 - Final invoice due August 31, 2026

- No RSI reimbursement funding for programs funded by Implementation Grants
- Board of Governors approval timing TBD
