RE: Formal Notification of Intent to Award for FY 2018-19, Refugee Career Pathways Grant Program (RFA #19-300-001)

This memorandum is a formal notification of the intent to award the Refugee Career Pathways Grant Program, **RFA 19-300-001** for the Workforce and Economic Development Division of the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office.

Pending Board of Governors approval as well as the availability of funds, commencement of Los Rios Community College District - Refugee Career Pathways Program is October 1, 2020. As the sole project application received, its funding status is listed below.

The grant application was reviewed and scored to determine if it received the minimum number of points eligible for funding (75 points). Only one application was received and reviewed in response to the RFA. There are four categories of funding status:

1. Funded (F).
2. Eligible-Not Funded (E-NF) Proposals in this category received the minimum number of points eligible for funding (75 points) but funding was insufficient to fund more than one proposal in that category.
3. Not Eligible (NE). This category includes proposals that did not achieve the minimum number of points on the evaluation.

4. Not Scored (NS). This category designates proposals that were rejected before being read for reasons listed in the RFA.

The Chancellor’s Office will contact the district receiving funding to request Face Sheets and any technical changes, including budgets, that are needed to complete the execution of the grant agreement. A copy of the fully executed grant agreement will be provided to the district.

For audit purposes, funded districts must retain a copy of the grant agreement, the RFA Specifications, and the Workforce and Economic Development Division Request for Applications Instructions, Terms and Conditions for three years. Collectively, these documents constitute the legally binding agreement to perform the specified work.
