



AB1111: Common Course Numbering (CCN)

High-Level Summary of Key Activities and Next Steps in Common Course Numbering (CCN) Development

- **AI and Technology Integration:** There are multiple conversations in progress exploring the use of AI in supporting the work of CCN.
- **Refinement of Workgroup Structures and Processes:** As the CCN implementation moves into 2025 and Phase III, the roles and composition of both the Development and Technology & Process Workgroups are evolving.
- **Student-Facing Communications:** A communications toolkit will be available in early to mid-March. The kit will include logos, PowerPoint templates, and video collateral for websites and social media. There will also be website buttons/toolbars that can integrate into colleges' homepages or registration pages that will direct users to CCN information.
- **Phase II Communication:** A memo, [ESS 25-11, Common Course Numbering \(CCN\) System Update and Implementation \(Phase II\)](#) was released on March 18, 2025.
- **Phase III Preparation:** Forty-seven courses were identified for Phase III to be student facing by Fall 2027.
- **Intersegmental & Communication:** On December 20, 2024, the Chancellor's Office convened a meeting with system and academic senate representatives from all three public systems, as well as representatives from AICCU. The objective of the meeting was to review CCN impact on articulation. Based on the conversation, the CSU Chancellor's Office has sent a message encouraging CSU campuses to complete template reviews by March 1.
