Re: **UPDATED** - EEO Fund Allocation for Fiscal Year 2019-2020

Dear Colleagues:

In July 2019, we notified all community college districts that each district that met the Multiple Methods requirements by the June 30, 2019 deadline would receive \$45,000 in EEO funds for the 2019-2020 fiscal year. On September 27, 2019, the Governor signed Senate Bill 109, granting the Chancellor's Office spending authority for an additional \$339,000 in Faculty Obligation Number (FON) penalties. These additional funds will permit the Chancellor's Office to apportion an additional \$5,000 per complying district for a total 2019-2020 EEO apportionment of \$50,000. We expect these additional funds to be paid out on or about February 28, 2020 in the P1 apportionment payment.

Although we cannot guarantee the same level of funding for fiscal year 2020-2021, the Chancellor's Office remains committed to advocating for increased EEO funding to support robust EEO programs at the local level. As always, we thank you for your continued efforts to ensure equal employment opportunities for all in the California Community Colleges.
