



## Promising Practices Showcase Poster Call for Proposals

The California Community College Chancellor's office Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) Program invites Southern California participants to present their promising practices in the **Equal Employment Opportunity Southern California Promising Practices Showcase on March 17<sup>th</sup>**. We make a special call to campuses identified as a champion committed to embedding diversity, equity, inclusion, and accessibility (DEIA) initiatives into their hiring practices and recently highlighted in our 2022 Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO)/Diversity Best Practices Handbook. **Deadline to submit interest to participate is February 24<sup>th</sup>**.

The poster for the showcase should be a combination of brief text, data, tables, graphs, pictures, and other presentation formats. The following is the criteria for the EEO Southern California Showcase's poster:

- Overview of a promising practice that highlights measurable outcomes
- Include graphics (highlighting campus/district data in relation to statewide statistics)
- Posters must be printed in landscape orientation (horizontal)
- Dimensions of the poster must be either 36" x 48" or 42" x 56"
- Matte finish is preferred
- Must not be printed on a foamboard
- A high-resolution JPEG of the poster for submission to the Equal Employment Opportunity online community
