- C. **System Updates** [Inform]
 - I. CCCCCO Update – Chad
 - a. DE RSI Webinar presented collaboratively between the ACCJC, ASCCC and DECO on April 29, 2025. Recording will be published to DE listserv and stored in the Vision Resource Center once remediated
 - b. Dreamscape Learn Biology Lab Courseware pilot program being rolled out to the field; accessibility confirmations and EEAAP template document for colleges being developed
 - c. AB 790 proposed legislation for California to join SARA
 - discussion about student location when taking courses out of state. Colleges must have a process for students to declare if they move out-of-state mid-semester. Also, if students are removed due to immigration status, colleges are responsible to meet international reciprocity agreements (if any) of new location country if education will continue to be provided to student via distance education
 - d. BOG Biennial Distance Education report to be written in fall 2025
 - II. CVC & @ONE Update – Marina Aminy
 - Currently at 23,120 cross enrollments for 2024/25. 109 Home Colleges, 76 teaching colleges, Course Finder API is up to 107 colleges and 114 colleges have signed financial aid consortium agreements.



- CVC rolling out of new financial aid dashboard for courses taken through the CVC exchange.
- CVC rolling out transcript automation for institution-to-institution transcripts for students. #freethetranscript tag is linked to activities that save students transcript expenses. This saves students money and no longer requires manual efforts. Soft launch will occur in May 2025 and include Spring 2025 transcripts
- Consortium charter updated to become an Exchange User Group. Tasks to be different than prior charter. Description of Consortium Lead roles and requirements are available upon request from the CVC. The goal of the new design is to troubleshoot tasks/technical support needs and maintenance of the CVC exchange.
- New course design rubric being explored by an advisory team to address AI, RSI, Privacy/Security, and Equity
- 81 facilitated sections for CVC@ONE in Spring, 53 sections for Summer
 - o Fall schedule will go live in July
 - o Working to conduct a large-scale fix for broken-links restoration and unpublished videos

D. Data Element and Data Mart – Chad & Todd Hoig [Inform & Consult]

- I. **XF01 MIS data element proposed changes:**
 - a. XF01 to be “Instruction Method”
 - c. Proposed new XF MIS data element to capture more accurate “Instructional Modality” data
 - i. Review of data from lesser used codes (highlighting those that are likely correspondence).
 - Recommend creating a training for session versus section data when reporting
 - ii. Recommend continuing ad hoc DEETAC team to explore:
(1) follow-up with colleges’ lesser used MIS submission data for clarity and (2) work on new needed codes
 - Recommendation: continue exploring session versus section coding of XF01 data element and new XF ## proposed data element.
 - Recommendation: consider presenting work of DEETAC and efforts to improve MIS data could at Curriculum Institute general session this summer
 - c. Legal determination regarding Hyflex courses to be counted as distance education courses is still pending
