



Bakersfield College CBE Redirection Policy

Purpose:

This spotlight features a sample direct assessment CBE redirection policy from [Bakersfield College](#). Bakersfield is piloting a culinary arts program.

Sample Policy:

Students who no longer wish to participate in a Competency-Based Education (CBE) program may return to standard credit hour programs at any time. To redirect their education journey, students must meet with the CBE counselor to discontinue the CBE program and transfer completed CBE units into standard credit hour units and submit the changes to Admissions and Records. The student will then meet with the pathway counselor of the credit hour program to register for courses.

Students will have the following options to transfer credits when moving into the credit hour program:

- The CBE courses are aligned with existing program courses. For completed CBE modules, the student may receive credit for the course equivalency and will be transcribed as credit for prior learning. The student must meet with the pathway counselor and fill out appropriate paperwork with Admissions and Records.
 - Students receiving a Mastery (M) grade will receive a 3.0 credit equivalency for completed coursework.
 - Students receiving a Mastery+ (M+) grade will receive a 4.0 credit equivalency for completed coursework.
- The student may receive an “Incomplete” or “In Progress” grade in for-credit course equivalency and work with the subject matter faculty members to complete missing portions as independent study to receive the for-credit course grade.
