Digest Item 1.2: Implementation of the 2023-24 Full-Time Faculty Obligation *(Wrenna Finche)*

This digest item presented the Council with information for the Board of Governors’ consideration in determining whether the Budget Act of 2023 provides adequate funding to support an increase in districts’ full-time faculty hiring obligations for Fall 2024.

Discussion Summary:

- CSEA inquired about the changes that would occur in the 50% law and Faculty Obligation Number (FON) if counselors and librarians were included.
- CCA/CTA inquired about the deficit factor applied.
- CCLC raised discussion about a partial FON increase.
