- CCCAOE raised discussion on support strategies for undocumented students.
- CCLC expressed higher priorities for one-time funding for deferred maintenance.
- CCE/CFT expressed concern about the technical assistance and monitoring of Title IX.
- CCCT requested a list of the workgroup.
- CSEA requested the inclusion of a classified representative in the workgroup.

- SSCCC echoed CSEA to uplift classified employees on the Title IX committee.

Digest Item 1.6: Credit for Prior Learning Funding Update

(Vice Chancellor Stanskas)

This digest item presented funds that would help to coordinate disjointed efforts to develop course credit recommendations for prior learning and experience obtained outside of the classroom and extend credit for prior learning (CPL) to populations who were unaware of the value that their prior experience has in higher education.
