This digest item provided updates on the minimum qualifications for faculty in various disciplines.

Item 5: State Budget May Revision Update & System Request Process

Presenters: Chris Ferguson, Executive Vice Chancellor, Finance and Strategic Initiatives; David O’Brien, Vice Chancellor, External Relations, and Linda Vazquez, Assistant Vice Chancellor, State and Federal Relations

This digest item provided an update on the May Revision of the Governor’s 2026–27 state budget and its implications for California Community Colleges, along with an overview of the forthcoming 2027–28 Shared Advocacy Request process and key state and federal policy, legislative, and advocacy developments.
