RE: FY 22-23 Apprenticeship Related and Supplemental Instruction Required Reporting.

This memorandum is to report to the California Apprenticeship Council the information required by <u>Education Code</u> Sections 8152, 79149.1, and 79149.3.

The Chancellor's Office allocates related and supplemental instruction (RSI) funding to K-12 Local Education Agencies (LEAs) and to Community College Districts (CCDs) annually based on state budget funded amounts as authorized by <u>Education Code</u> Sections 8150 and 79149.3. In FY 22-23, the Chancellor's Office was ultimately allocated a total of \$89,720,000. The allocation is split per the Budget Act by separate schedules respectively for the K-12 LEAs and the CCDs:

- \$39,948,000 to reimburse CCDs
- \$49,772,000 to reimburse LEAs

In addition, the Chancellor's Office separately reimburses attendance of apprentices enrolled in any class offered for community college credit by a community college, via apportionment, in collaboration with an apprenticeship program sponsor, pursuant to <u>Labor Code</u> Section 3074, as part of the budget formula developed pursuant to <u>Education Code</u> Section 84750.5 as authorized by <u>Education Code</u> Section 79149.1. This funding is taken from an institution's regular SCFF base apportionment allocation supporting <u>Education Code</u> Section 8152 and 79149.3.

For the FY 22-23, the total claimed was:

• \$6,680,554- claimed by CCDs via SCFF base apportionment for apprenticeship courses.

From these sources, apprenticeship programs received **\$96,400,554** in state dollars in FY 22-23 specifically to reimburse the costs to provide apprentices RSI.

CCD that claimed RSI and apportionment funding for FY 22-23.
