RE: California Apprenticeship Initiative New and Innovative Grant Program:

FY 23-24 Notice of Intent to Award (Pending Board Approval)

This memorandum is a formal notification of the intent to award California Apprenticeship Initiative New and Innovative Grant Program (CAI Program) funding by the Chancellor's Office Workforce and Economic Development Division for FY 23-24.

The CAI Program grants awarded to selected California community colleges, K-12 local education agencies, and other entities, collectively identified as Grantees in Tables 1 through 5, are intended to create new and innovative apprenticeship opportunities in priority and emerging industry sectors or areas. These new programs should be apprenticeship training that is not fully established or currently does not exist. Grant award amounts are based on amounts requested in the grant applications. Up to \$1,500,000 was allowed for Apprenticeship Program Implementation Grants, \$1,000,000 for Apprenticeship Program Expansion Grants, \$500,000 for Pre-Apprenticeship Implementation Grants, and \$120,000 for Planning Grants. These investments will target the key career education strategy of vastly expanding registered pre-apprenticeship and apprenticeships as reflected in Vision 2030, which is the strategic blueprint for our 116-community college system. As the largest workforce training program in the nation, the California community colleges through these grant recipients will not only achieve Vision 2030 goals but also address the Governor's top workforce priority.

The Chancellor's Office deeply appreciates and acknowledges the efforts of all applicants in the FY 23-24 CAI Program application round. Our office received 210 applications requesting more than \$103 million. In carefully reviewing the submissions, the applicants put significant time, research, and planning into their work. In future years, the Chancellor's Office is committed to pursue substantially additional funding to make awards to all eligible submissions.

The Chancellor's Office encourages all applicants to consider the following funding sources to braid funding support and grow their programs (sources are hyperlinks):

- 6. Women in Apprenticeship and Nontraditional Occupations (Pre-apprenticeship specific)

- 8. Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act of 2006 (Perkins) (Federal)

Grant Awards

To make award decisions, as described in the request for application (RFA) document, the Chancellor's Office awarded points to applicants in three categories: 1) RFA Requirements; 2) Occupation Proportion of Regional Labor Market Demand; and 3) Cost per Apprentice or Pre-Apprentice. The Chancellor's Office also gave an additional 5 points to applications that indicated apprentices would receive community college credit, and another 5 points to applications where the apprenticeship program resulted or directly tied into a degree. Finally, the Chancellor's Office prioritized applications for programs supported by a previous CAI planning grant. The Chancellor's Office totaled these points to establish a Final Score, ranked all applications by their Final Score regardless of grant purpose, largest to smallest, and awarded to as many applications in rank order as funding permitted. To determine these scores:

- 1. **RFA Requirements** (**RFA Score**): The Chancellor's Office FY 23-24 application review team (Review Team) reviewed each application to determine whether the content of the application met the RFA requirements. If it did, the application was awarded either 75 or 80 points, depending on the grant purpose. If the application did not meet the RFA requirements, it received 0 points for this factor.
- 2. Occupation Proportion of Regional Labor Market Demand (RLMD Score): The Review Team identified the primary occupation included within each application. If an application included multiple primary occupations, counter to the direction of the RFA and NOVA application, the team used the first occupation cited. The Review Team then looked up in the Labor Market Information resource tool (LMI Tool) the occupation identified in the RFA and within the NOVA application. The team identified the Annual Job Openings for the primary occupation within the region identified in the application. If the primary

occupation included in the application did not align to the LMI Tool as directed in the RFA and NOVA application, the team did its best to select the closest comparable occupation in the LMI Tool. The team then divided the Annual Job Openings for the occupation by the Annual Job Openings for the region (LMI Base Score). The LMI Base Scores were ranked largest to smallest within each grant purpose grouping. For each grouping, the application with the greatest LMI Base Score was awarded 15 or 20 points, depending on the grant purpose. The remaining applications received a score in proportion to their LMI Base Score divided by the largest LMI Base Score in that grouping (see chart below as illustration).

3. Cost per Apprentice or Pre-Apprentice (Cost Score) [Not applicable to Planning Grants]: The Review Team identified the number of apprentices or pre-apprentices that the application planned to register with the Division of Apprenticeship Standards during the grant performance period and divided that amount by total budget cost of the application. This average cost per apprentice or pre-apprentice was ranked smallest to largest within each grant purpose grouping. For each grouping, the application with the smallest average cost per apprentice or pre-apprentice was awarded 10 points. The team then found the difference between the smallest average cost per apprentice or pre-apprentice and the expected outcome average cost included in the RFA [either \$2,500 per pre-apprentice or \$15,000 per apprentice] to find the Group Cost Range. The remaining applications received 9 through 0 points depending on where their average cost per apprentice or pre-apprentice fell within the Group Cost Range (see chart below as illustration).

The results of this overall application scoring are outlined in the tables below. Table 1 through Table 4 are grant awards in alphabetical order, broken up by grant purpose per table and presented by Funding Status, Region, then Grantee, and finally Primary Occupation within each

table. The legend for terms used in these charts is:

- Funded: indicates applicants that met the requirements of the request for application and that were ranked high enough to receive a grant award.
- Not Funded: indicates applicants that met the requirements of the RFA but that did not rank high enough to receive a grant award.
- ➤ **Ineligible:** indicates applicants did not meet the requirements of the RFA. A reason is noted.
- Occupations with an asterisk symbol indicate applications that were continuations of previous CAI planning grants, and that were prioritized for award.

Table 5 includes grant scoring details for all applications and is presented in alphabetical order by Grantee.

Appeals

Applicants have ten (10) business days from the day this memorandum is distributed and posted online to submit an appeal. If an appeal is submitted during this period, the grants affected will not be awarded until the appeal is resolved. The appeal must specify the grounds of appeal and must be based on the process and/or procedures used in the review and recommendation of application for awards. The appeal must be emailed with an email header of "CAI Appeal: TIME SENSITIVE" and addressed to the Dean of the program responsible for funding the project: gadams@cccco.edu.

Next Steps

Before the execution of grant award agreements, grant awards must be approved by the California Community Colleges Board of Governors (Board of Governors). Awards are anticipated to be submitted for approval by the Board of Governors during its March 2024 meeting date. Additionally, prior to execution of grant award agreements, Chancellor's office staff may contact Grantees to request adjustments or modifications to the work plan and/or budget submitted as part of the grant application.
