RE: FY 2024-25 Rebuilding Nursing Infrastructure Grant Request for Applications

The California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office is pleased to announce the release of a Request for Application (RFA) for the Rebuilding Nursing Infrastructure (RNI) grant program.

Background and Purpose

California faces a looming healthcare crisis with projections indicating a critical shortage of registered nurses by 2030. In response to this urgent need, the RNI grant program funded by Proposition 98 aims to address the nursing shortfall.

The RNI grant program's primary objective is to close critical healthcare workforce gaps by expanding educational pathways for nursing degrees in California community colleges, and by developing innovative nursing programs, partnerships, and infrastructures to support, grow, and foster the next generation of registered nurses. In short, the initiative seeks to increase the number of qualified nursing graduates equipped to enter the workforce and ensure the sustainability of high-quality healthcare for California residents.
