This memo provides updates to the Rising Scholars Network grant awards for 2025–2028.

The California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office is pleased to announce that all colleges that applied to the Rising Scholars Network program for 2025–28 will receive funding as a result of an increase in state funding and the removal of the original cap on the number of participating colleges. The Chancellor's Office appreciates and acknowledges the strong commitment of all colleges that applied. A list of awardees and funding details can be found in Table 1.

The Rising Scholars Network (RSN) is a statewide initiative of the California Community Colleges designed to expand access to higher education for justice-involved individuals, including those who are currently or formerly incarcerated. Serving over 20,000 students across community college campuses and correctional facilities, RSN offers programs such as Adult Programs, Juvenile Justice, and Textbooks/Digital Course Content. This expansion reflects California's growing commitment to advancing the Vision 2030 goals of equity in access, equity in support, and equity in success. With increased investment, colleges can strengthen or launch programs that support academic achievement, ease reentry transitions, enable transfer, and create pathways to livable wage careers—continuing our collective work to build opportunities for justice-impacted students.

Grant Execution & Payments: Grant agreements are expected to be finalized in fall 2025.
 Initial payments will be issued after all agreements are fully executed.
