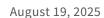

RE: Formal Notification of Related and Supplemental Instruction FY 25-26 Initial Allocations

This memorandum is a formal notification of the initial allocation of Related and Supplemental Instruction (RSI) hours funded by 2025-26 appropriations. Upon appropriation by the Legislature, the Chancellor of the California Community Colleges (Chancellor) is responsible for allocating funds for apprenticeship programs in good standing and approved pursuant to Chapter 4 of Division 3 of the California Labor Code, consistent with subdivision (e) of Education Code Section 8152 or 79149.3 to reimburse RSI maintained by a school district (collectively referred to as LEA), a county office of education (also referred to as LEA), or a community college district.

In 2025-26, the Legislature appropriated a total of \$98,107,000 for RSI reimbursement. This is an overall increase of \$2,567,000 from 2024-25. The 2025-26 schedule breakdown is as follows:

A list of LEAs, community college districts and their 2025-26 initial allocations is included in this memorandum. There was a cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) RSI hourly rate increase from \$10.05 to \$10.32 in the 2025-26 Budget Act. The 2025-26 allocation amounts are projected based on hours reported by LEAs and community college districts during ReCalc for 2023-24, taking into consideration the COLA increase. There will be a final funding adjustment for 2025-26 after the ReCalc reports in NOVA are received, which are currently due Nov. 1, 2026.

Fiscal Reporting Reminder

Fiscal reports are still due in NOVA with Chief Business Officer (CBO) certification by the deadline. Failure to submit fiscal reports with CBO certification by the deadline may impact funding.

Reporting Schedule

Reporting Period	Due Date	Description
Budget Year Projection	Oct. 1	Please include an estimate of the RSI hours that will be provided in the Budget Year (the following fiscal year), including each program/occupation combination that the LEA or community college district plans to report hours for, the number of hours allocated to each program, and the number of unduplicated apprentices anticipated to receive instruction.
P1	Jan. 31	Please include all confirmed RSI hours that were provided starting July 1 through Dec. 31. Identify each program/occupation combination that provided instruction, the number of hours of instruction provided by that program/occupation combination, and the number of unduplicated apprentices that received instruction through that program/occupation combination. Only report confirmed RSI hours if it is unclear whether instruction occurred, do not report those hours. If any apprentices received instruction, but then dropped out or were removed from the program, those apprentices and hours should be counted.
P2	May 31	Please include all confirmed RSI hours that were provided starting July 1 through April 30. Identify each program/occupation combination that provided RSI, the number of RSI hours provided by that program/occupation combination, and the number of unduplicated apprentices that received instruction through that program/occupation combination. Only report confirmed RSI hours if it is unclear whether instruction occurred, do not report those hours.

Important to Note

- 1. It is imperative that LEAs and community college districts provide accurate and timely submissions during every reporting period. Although the California Community College Chancellor's Office (Chancellor's Office) may send periodic reminders, it is the responsibility of the LEA and community college district to ensure their reports are accurately submitted and approved by their CBO or equivalent prior to the deadline.
- 2. The Chancellor's Office is unaware of staffing changes. Therefore, it is the responsibility of the LEAs and community college districts to ensure access is granted as required. The Chancellor's Office may support with granting access as needed.
- 3. RSI payout will be based primarily on recalculation data submitted, subject to availability of funding. Any LEA or community college district that does not submit their recalculation report and have CBO or equivalent certify their recalculation submission by the Nov. 1, 2026 deadline is subject to a subsequent impact on funding paid out. Furthermore, failing to report by the Nov. 1, 2026 recalculation deadline will mean that the LEA or community college district may not receive further funding from the total funds available from the recalculation for that fiscal year. RSI reports which are approved during the Budget Year Projection, P1, and P2 periods do not guarantee LEA or community college district will receive the funding.
- **4.** Although payment is made based on recalculation data, all reports must still be submitted and approved by the deadlines specified.
- **5.** RSI hours must be specific to RSI instruction, not On the Job Training hours. Any compensation for OJT hours may not be double counted for RSI funding.
