RE: FY 2026-27 Perkins Headcount Certification in NOVA

This memo provides guidance on how districts are to certify student headcount data in the Chancellor's Office NOVA system. Districts must verify and certify student headcounts in NOVA prior to receiving fiscal year (FY) 2026-27 funds as the headcount information is used in the Perkins Title I-C funding allocation formula. The Chancellor's Office is requesting districts to certify their data **no later than March 2, 2026**. The Perkins V Title I-C funding allocation for FY 2026-27 is based on the FY 2024-25 enrollment of Unduplicated Career Technical Education (CTE) Disadvantaged Student Headcount by District and College data that is required to be submitted to the Chancellor's Office Management Information System (MIS). These reports will be linked for viewing in the NOVA system.

Background

The Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21st Century Act (Perkins V) was signed into law on July 31, 2018, and took effect on July 1, 2019. The law reauthorized and updated the Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act of 2006 to ensure career and technical education (CTE) programs meet the demands of the twenty-first-century economy. Perkins V represents an important opportunity to expand opportunities for every student to explore, choose, and follow CTE programs of study and career pathways to complete their educational goals and achieve a positive workforce outcome. The local application under Perkins V is comprised of a Comprehensive Local Needs Assessment (CLNA), application narrative related to local uses of funding, a budget proposal, and targets for meeting the State Determined Levels of Performance (SDLPs) for the core indicators. In alignment with student equity as a core component of Perkins V, community college districts should emphasize designing appropriate programs of study to ensure students from all backgrounds succeed in reaching their educational and career goals while striving to eliminate achievement gaps for all.

The Importance of Headcount Certification in NOVA

For FY 2026-27, the Perkins funding allocations will be determined based on 2024-25 economically disadvantaged criteria for students enrolled in CTE programs and unduplicated headcounts by district and college. Districts must verify and certify student headcounts in NOVA prior to receiving FY 2026-27 funds, as the headcount information is used in the Perkins Title I-C funding allocation formula. The Chancellor's Office has made 90% of the FY 2025-26 (current) year allocation amounts available in NOVA for colleges and districts to begin developing the FY 2026-27 local applications. An additional memo will be distributed containing the final FY 2026-27 funding allocations once the Chancellor's Office receives the federal award letter and funding split from the California Department of Education (CDE). The Preliminary Reports 1 and 2 for FY 2026-27 headcount certification will be attached to this memo and posted on the Perkins program webpage.

Step by Step Certification in NOVA

The following are instructions on completing student headcount certification for the Perkins Title I-C funding allocation for fiscal year 2026-27. Note: Only a Chief Executive Officer (CEO) or their designee may complete the headcount certification process.

Step 1 – Login to NOVA

- Visit NOVA.CCCCO.edu to login to NOVA system.

Step 2 – Within the Navigation bar, locate your district's Headcount Certification page:

- Choose "Programs"
- "Perkins"
- "Title IC"
- "Headcount"
- Choose your district and complete the certification process.

Step 3 – Verify that the CEO or designee and contact information for your district is current and accurate in NOVA.

If there has been a change in your district's CEO or if the CEO would like to designate another person to complete headcount reporting, the Project Director has NOVA permissions to change. Should this not be an option, please submit a [Help Desk ticket](#) through NOVA.

Step 4 – Certifying District Data

Each district will certify the CTE economically disadvantaged student counts (Column 5 within Report 1 through NOVA by Monday, March 2, 2026. For more step-by-step instructions on how to complete the Perkins Headcount Certification process, watch the [NOVA tutorial video](#).
