FY 25–26 Notice of Intent to Award (Pending Board of Governors Approval)

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This memorandum is a formal notification of the intent to award California Apprenticeship Initiative New and Innovative Grant Program (CAI Program) funding by the Chancellor’s Office Workforce and Economic Development Division for 2025–26.

The CAI Program grants awarded to selected California community colleges, K–12 local education agencies, and other related entities, collectively identified as “Grantees” in Tables 2 through 4, are intended to create new and innovative apprenticeship opportunities in priority and emerging industry sectors or areas. Grant award amounts are based on amounts requested in the grant applications. Up to \$1.5 million was allowed for Apprenticeship and Pre-Apprenticeship Program Implementation Grants and up to \$1 million for Apprenticeship Expansion Grants. These investments will target the key career education strategy of vastly expanding registered pre-apprenticeships and apprenticeships as reflected in Vision 2030, which is the strategic blueprint for our 116-community college system.

The Chancellor’s Office deeply appreciates and acknowledges the efforts of all applicants in 2025–26 CAI Program application round. Our office received 178 applications requesting \$147,387,416. In carefully reviewing the submissions, the applicants put significant time, research, and planning into their work. The Chancellor’s Office is committed to pursue additional funding to expand awards.

### **Grant Awards**

To make award decisions, as described in the request for application (RFA) document, the Chancellor’s Office application review team (Review Team) reviewed each application to determine whether the content of the application met the RFA requirements. Applications must have received at least 75 points to be eligible for award consideration, although meeting this minimum requirement did not guarantee funding.

Each application was awarded up to 100 points distributed within the categories of Budget, Supporting Documents, Implementation/Expansion, and Work Plan. Priority consideration was provided to programs:

1. Registered or in the process of obtaining registration with the California Division of Apprenticeship Standards
2. Demonstrating a lower cost per student, thereby serving a greater number of students
3. Included strong, valid labor market demand information to demonstrate the need for apprenticeship programs within an occupation and/or industry sector
4. Demonstrating program sustainability

Applications were selected for an award in order of highest review score to lowest review score, until available funding was depleted. The Chancellor’s Office totaled these points to establish a final score, ranked all applications by their final score, and awarded to as many applications in rank order as funding permitted.

The results of this overall application scoring are outlined in the tables below. Table 2 through Table 4 include all grant applications presented by School, Application Title, Funding Status, and Budget within each table. The legend for terms used in these charts is:

- **Funded:** indicates applicants that met the requirements of the request for application and that were ranked high enough to receive a grant award.
- **Not Funded:** applicants whose proposals were reviewed and scored but were not among the highest-ranked applications selected for funding, regardless of whether the minimum score threshold was met.

Please keep in mind that all apprenticeship and pre-apprenticeship programs must obtain formal approval by the California Division of Apprenticeship Standards (DAS), and dual registration with the United States Department of Labor (DOL) is strongly encouraged.

### **Appeals**

Applicants have ten (10) business days from the day this memorandum is distributed and posted online to submit an appeal. If an appeal is submitted during this period, the grants affected will not be awarded until the appeal is resolved. The appeal must specify the grounds of appeal and must be based on the process and/or procedures used in the review and recommendation of application for awards. The appeal must be emailed with an email header of “CAI Appeal: TIME SENSITIVE” and addressed to [Apprenticeship@CCCCO.edu](mailto:Apprenticeship@CCCCO.edu).

### **Next Steps**

Before the execution of grant award agreements, grant awards must be approved by the California Community Colleges Board of Governors. Awards are anticipated to be submitted for approval by the Board of Governors during its May 2026 meeting date. Additionally, prior to execution of grant award agreements, Chancellor’s Office staff may contact Grantees to request adjustments or modifications to the work plan and/or budget submitted as part of the grant application.

Should sufficient funds be appropriated during 2026–27, the Chancellor’s Office may choose to fund additional applicants from the existing request for applications (RFA) applicants who met the minimum score requirements and were previously unfunded.
