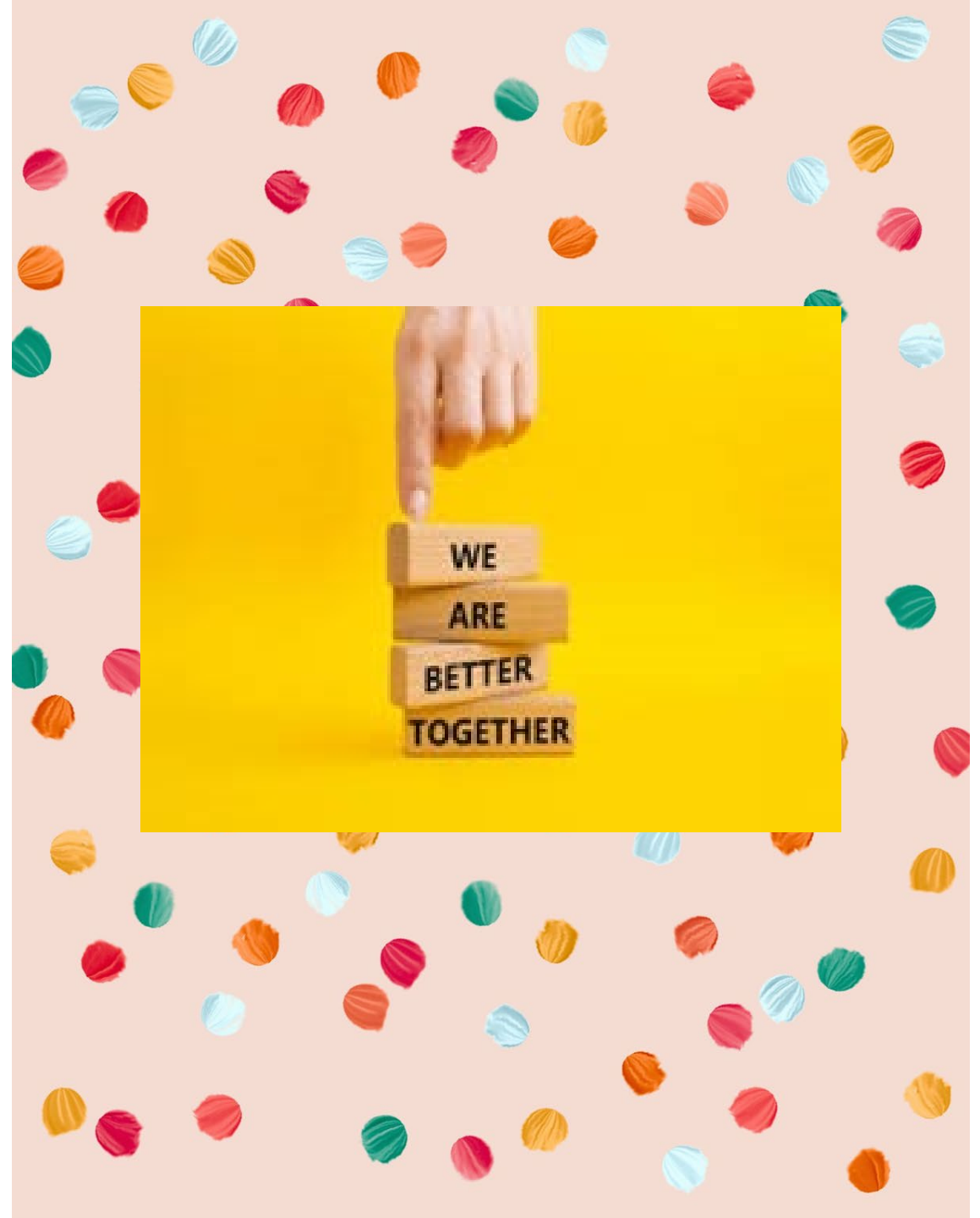

# K12 Pathway Coordinators are vital

Pathway Coordinators play a vital role in aligning K12 and college programs to ensure smooth transitions for students pursuing career and technical education (CTE). The objectives focus on:

- ✓ Strengthening Partnerships
- ✓ Supporting Dual Enrollment
- ✓ Enhancing Vertical Alignment
- ✓ Addressing Disproportionality
- ✓ Facilitating Professional Development
- ✓ Monitoring and Reporting



# 2024-25 PC Objectives *updated Spring 2024*

- **Objective 1:** On behalf of the designated community college service area, serve as a point of contact between K-12 and community college CTE programs to create, improve, and expand K-14 career pathways that address regional industry needs.

- **Objective 2:** Provide technical assistance throughout a designated service area to ensure the offering of high-quality CTE programs and securing of K-12 strong workforce program, CTEIG, and other state and local funding for LEA's.

- **Objective 3:** Facilitate the use of data to identify existing pathways and gaps among service area K12 and community colleges and help make recommendations for furthering pathway development to ensure student success.

- **Objective 4:** Facilitate the development and implementation of Career Exploration to educate K-12 students about family-sustaining occupations available.

- **Objective 5:** Support postsecondary transitions and completion of certificate and degree programs to prepare students for occupations that provide a livable wage.

- **Objective 6:** Provide technical assistance to LEAs within the assigned service area to inform the development of Work-Based Learning (WBL) opportunities for K-12 students to gain the knowledge, skills, and network of a given occupation.
