Strengthen CTE programs and pathways: Collaborate with community colleges, industry, and organizations to improve CTE programs that meet regional workforce needs.

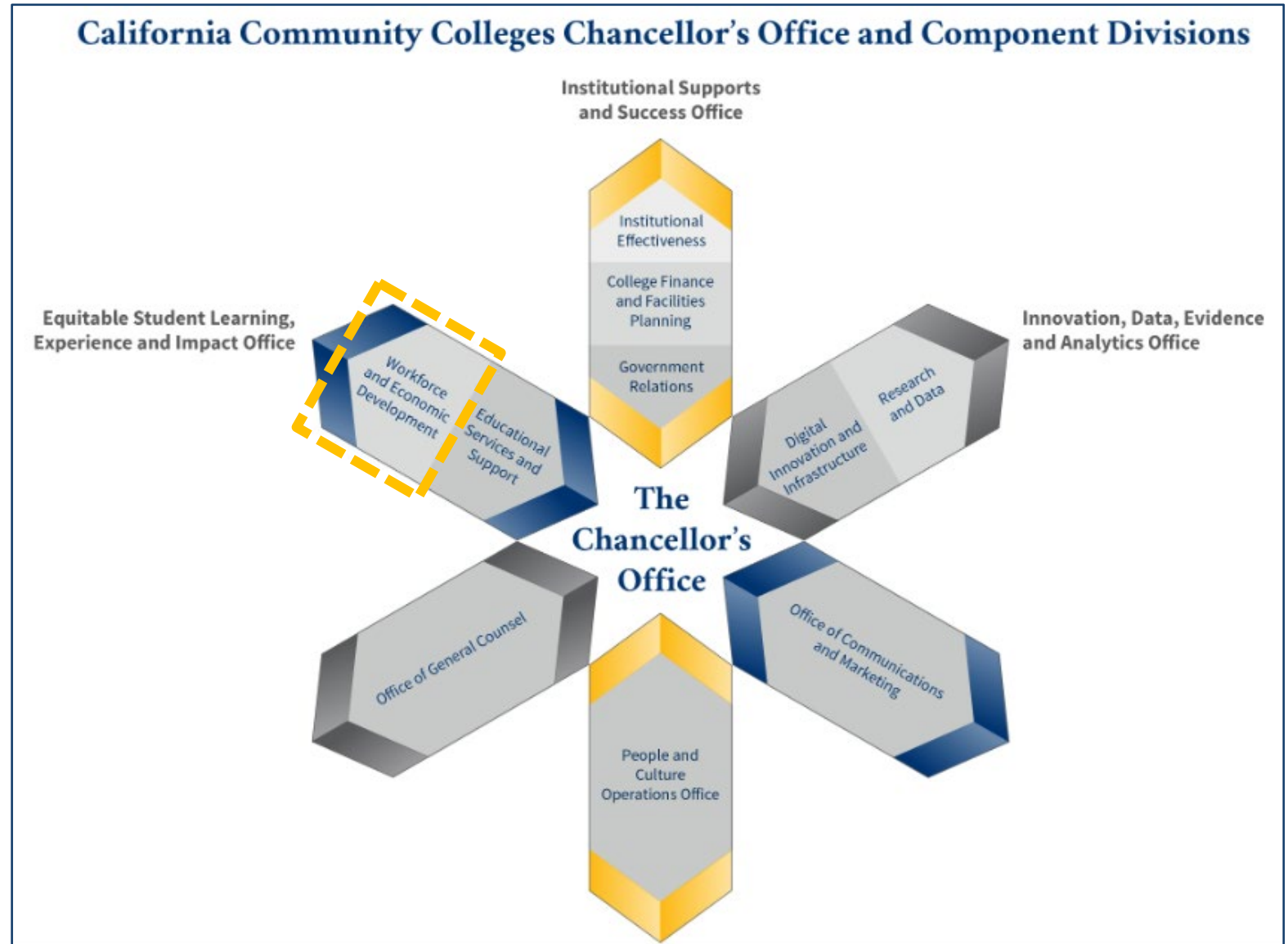
Develop high-quality K–14 CTE sequences, programs, and pathways: Create K14 CTE courses that:

Role and Responsibilities:

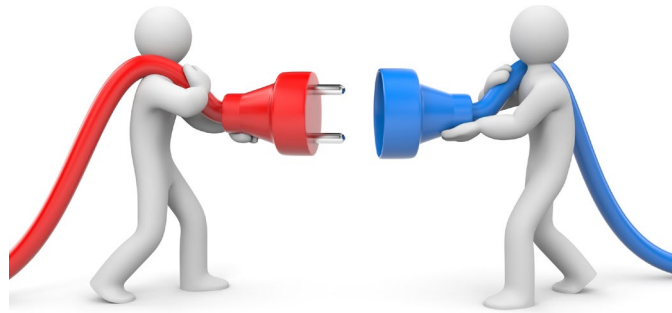
- Provide regional leadership and support for K12 SWP initiatives.

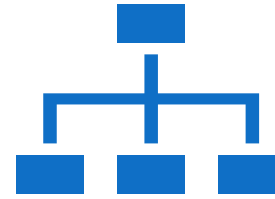

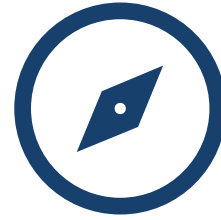

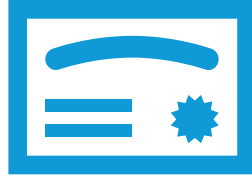
