Career Pathways Definition

A Career Pathway is

A framework for connecting a series of educational courses with work based learning experience and student support services that prepares a student for entry level employment in an identified occupation (sector).

Definition of K14 Articulation

Aligns secondary career technical education (CTE) courses with community college CTE certificates and/or degree programs.

Awarding college credit for courses completed in secondary education that meets the same student outcomes as the identified college courses.

Utilizes Credit-by-Exam process based on faculty agreement.

Definition of Dual/Concurrent Enrollment

Students individually taking a college course

CCAP Dual Enrollment Course – offered on high school campus during the school day.

Non CCAP dual Enrollment Course – Offered either on high school or college campus outside of school day.
