CA Community College System Size

- 116 Colleges – 72 Districts
- 72 Centers
- 200 Career Education Programs – (7 out of 10 nurses, 8 out of 10 Police, Firefighters, & EMTs).
- 15,000 Jobs with Starting Salaries at \$40,000
- 1/3 of UC Students Begin at Community Colleges
- 15 Bachelor's Degree Programs at CA Community Colleges
- 1.8 Million Students – 50% Do Not Pay Fees

Governance of System

Board of Governors – Governing Body

Chancellor – CEO of Board of Governors

18 Voting Members (students, Academic Senate Rep – Tenured Faculty, Classified Employees, & Lieutenant Governor)

Consultation Council – Ensures representatives from all levels of the Community College System has a voice on policy decisions.

Deputy Chancellor – Chairs Consultation Committee

Members from the following: Trustees, CEO, CIO, CSSO, CCCAOE, Academic Senate, CTA, CSEA, Student Senate, etc.

Chancellor's Office - Nine Divisions

1. **College Finance and Facilities Planning** – Oversees local assistance & Capital Outlay for 72 Districts.
2. **Digital Innovation and Infrastructure** – Technology focused initiatives
3. **Office of Equitable Student Services & Learning Impact** – Curriculum and Support Services (Guided Pathways & Success Vision)
4. **Government Relations** – Represents CA Community Colleges to State and Federal Legislators

Chancellor's Office - Nine Divisions

5. **Institutional Effectiveness (Institutional Effectiveness Partnership Initiative -IEPI)** – Focus on Accreditation Issues & State & Federal Audits.
6. **Internal Operations** – Ensures Chancellor's Office pilot the strategic success of community colleges & students.
7. **Office of Communication & Marketing** – Reports and Marketing Materials
8. **Office of General Counsel** – legal counsel to Chancellor and interpretations of laws.

 - CTE assigned SAM Code
 - Courses lead to Certificate and/or Associate Degree.

Community College Assets

- Postsecondary education that leads to a JOB.

- Smaller class sizes with accessible faculty and FREE support services.
- Affordable post secondary education, even if don't qualify for financial aid.
