

K12 SWP CTE Pathway/Program Work Plan Template

The Work Plan template is offered as a planning tool. Your final work plan will be entered directly into the NOVA platform.

As stated in the RFA, applicants are asked to identify only the K14 Pathway Strategy (or Strategies) that the project will focus on using K12 SWP funds. For each strategy selected, Items 1 and 2 will be scored individually and the sum of those scores will be averaged. Items 3, 4, and 5 will be scored once. There is no penalty to applications that focus on one Strategy. The CTE Pathway/Program Work Plan is worth 35 total points. Your application will be scored on only the Strategy(ies) selected.

Important reminders to completing the K12 SWP Work Plan:

- Be certain that it supports your stated Project Objective(s).
- Include the leading metrics that will be requested in the progress reports.
