**K12 STRONG WORKFORCE PROGRAM DASHBOARD**

The K12 Strong Workforce Program (SWP) dashboard examines Career Technical Education engagement and completion for students at institutions awarded K12 SWP funding. This initial release of the dashboard includes data from grantees in Round 1 K12 SWP funding for School Years 2018-19 and 2019-20. During the webinar participants will:

- Learn about the suite of dashboards that make up the LaunchBoard, a statewide data system supported by the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office and hosted by Cal-PASS Plus
- Gain an understanding of the metrics, drilldowns, and resources-included in this first release of the K12 SWP dashboard added to the LaunchBoard
- Explore how to navigate to find information for your institution, LEA, county, region or statewide
- Better understand the current limitations of the Cal-PASS Plus data compared to other CDE sources for similar metrics and for drilldowns
- Find out what is planned for future releases of the dashboard

## **BACKGROUND ON THE K12 STRONG WORKFORCE PROGRAM**

In 2016, the California Legislature approved the Strong Workforce Program (SWP), budgeting an ongoing \$248 million for the state's community colleges to enhance and expand career technical education (CTE) and workforce training to prepare students for high-wage employment in industries that meet regional labor market needs. Commencing with the 2018–19 fiscal year, an additional \$150 million was allocated on an annual and ongoing basis to K-12 local education agencies (LEAs) through the K12 Strong Workforce Program (K12 SWP) to create, support, or expand high-quality CTE at the K-12 level.
