- Request Clarification of the minimum of 5 workplan objectives--that would be overall but not necessarily all are shared. Is there a minimum number of shared objectives that the regional consortia must have?
 No, but the Chancellor's Office is interested in maximizing collaboration within regions throughout the state.
- So we have to have nine signature pages? The Chancellor's Office is interested in spurring collaborative regional planning, not in generating undue or extra paperwork. As a result of consultation with the field, Appendix H (Collaborative Regional Workplan Certification) is being withdrawn from the grant renewal process. It will be replaced by a worksheet in Appendix B (Applications Forms). To certify your participation in the collaborative process, print and sign the worksheet, and include a PDF of the signed document in your grant renewal application packet. - Aren't subcontracts different than contracts? Subcontracts would be hiring someone
 to assume responsibility for the grant not activities allowed under the grant. At least
 that is my understanding. Meaning that a college couldn't accept the grant and then
 subcontract the work of the DSN to another college or agency.
