Frequently Asked Questions Suspension of Year-Four IEPI Framework of Indicators Goal Setting

- Q: I've heard about the suspension of the Year-Four goals, and would like to learn more. Where can I go to find information on the suspension?
- A: Chancellor Oakley's February 2018 letter, "Suspending Requirement and Process for Adopting Institutional Effectiveness Partnership Initiative (IEPI) Goals Framework and Setting Year-Four IEPI College/District Goals," is available on the Institutional Effectiveness Division page of the CCCCO website. - Q: The Chancellor's letter states the following: "As a result of this transition, the Chancellor's Office will deem continued posting by districts and colleges of the Year-Three framework sufficient to comply with section 84754.6." What does "continued posting" mean, exactly?
- A: "Continued posting" means that the goals framework and the college/district goals set in Year Three (which are already posted on the IEPI data portal and on college/district websites) meet the requirement outlined in statute. The colleges/districts do not need to set new goals for Year Four.
