5	Article 1. Proportionate Direct Costs for Use of College Facilities and Grounds.
6

8	
9	§ 59601. Definitions.
10	(a) "Applicant" means the direct cost fee payer requesting use of college facilities or
11	grounds (Education Code section 82537 et seq.).
12	(b) "Direct costs" are the estimated costs identified by a community college district
13	as follows:
14	(1) "Capital direct costs" include the estimated costs for maintenance, repair,
15	restoration, and refurbishment for use of the college facilities or grounds pursuant to
16	Education Code section 82542.
17	(A) For purposes of estimating capital direct costs, "college facilities" shall be limited
18	to nonclassroom space, but may apply to specialty teaching spaces, including, but not
19	limited to, dance studios, music practice or performance spaces, and theaters.
20	(B) Capital direct costs shall not apply to classroom-based programs that operate
21	after school hours, including, but not limited to, after school programs, tutoring
22	programs, or child care programs.
23	1. A program is defined as classroom-based for purposes of this subdivision if
24	participants spend at least 50 percent of operational hours in a classroom.
25	(C) Capital direct costs shall not apply to organizations retained by the college or
26	community college district to provide instruction or instructional activities to students
27	during school hours.
28	(2) "Operational direct costs" include the estimated costs of supplies, utilities,
29	janitorial services, services of any other community college district employees and/or
30	contracted workers, and salaries and benefits paid to community college district
31	employees directly associated with the administration of the direct cost user fees to

1	operate and maintain school facilities or grounds.
2	(c) The term "College grounds" shall include, but not be limited to, playing fields,
3	athletic fields, track and field venues, tennis courts, and outdoor basketball courts.

7	§ 59602. Determining Proportionate Share.
8	Community college districts electing to charge applicants for all direct costs, or either
9	capital direct costs or operational direct costs, shall do the following:
10	(a) Calculate the proportionate share, as a percent, that each college facility or
11	grounds is available for use by applicants as follows:
12	(1) Estimate the total annual hours a college facility or grounds is expected to be
13	used by applicants.
14	(2) Estimate the total annual hours a college facility or grounds is expected to be
15	used by anyone, including applicants and the community college district.
16	(3) Divide the number of hours in subdivision (a)(1) by the number of hours in
17	subdivision (a)(2).
18	(b) In the alternative, community college districts may elect to determine
19	proportionate share by categorizing like college facilities or grounds (e.g., all football
20	fields, all gymnasiums) and performing the same calculation as outlined in subdivisions
21	(a)(1) through (a)(3).

25	§ 59603. Determining Specific Allowable Capital Direct Costs.
26	
27	Specific to each college facility and grounds (or like college facilities and grounds as
28	described in section 59602(b)), the community college district shall quantify annual
29	capital direct costs as follows:
30	(a) Determine the useful life in years from the initial date of occupancy or use.
31	(b) Estimate the expected cost to maintain, repair, restore, or refurbish the college

1	facility or grounds at the end of its useful life. Substitute the estimated cost to replace a
2	college facility or grounds when maintenance, repair, restoration or refurbishment would
3	not be practicable or cost effective.
4	(c) Divide the cost in subdivision (b) over the number of years in subdivision (a) to
5	reflect the annual cost.

8	
9	§59604. Determining Specific Allowable Operational Direct Costs.
10	Specific to each college facility and grounds (or like college facilities and grounds as
11	described in section 59602(b)), the community college district shall quantify annual
12	operational direct costs by estimating the following costs:
13	(a) The annual cost of salaries and benefits for all community college district
14	employee labor or contracted services required to operate, clean, and maintain the
15	school facility or grounds, which may include janitorial services, setup and teardown
16	time, and security.
17	(b) The annual cost of supplies required to operate and maintain the college facility
18	or grounds, including all community college district equipment used by applicants.
19	(c) The annual cost of utilities required to operate the college facility or grounds.
20	including any community college district or applicant-provided equipment.
21	(d) The prorated annual salaries and benefits paid to community college district
22	employees directly associated with the administration of direct cost user fees for time
23	spent administering such fees authorized under this article.

27	§59605. Establishing a Fee Schedule.
28	(a) When electing to charge fees pursuant to Education Code 82542, a community
29	college district governing board shall adopt a fee schedule that includes the hourly fee
30	for each specific school facility and grounds (or like college facilities and grounds as
31	described in section 59602(b)), calculated as follows:

1	(1) If charging for capital direct costs only, multiply the capital direct costs quantified
2	in section 59603(c) by the proportionate share as determined in section 59602(a)(3).
3	Divide the product by the total number of hours of applicant use as set forth in section
4	59602(a)(1) to arrive at the hourly rate.
5	(2) If charging for operational costs only, add the operational costs identified in
6	sections 59604(a) through (c) and multiply the sum by the proportionate share as
7	determined in section 59602(a)(3). Divide the product by the total number of hours of
8	applicant use as set forth in section 59602(a)(1) to arrive at an hourly rate. Add to this
9	amount the hourly rate to administer direct cost user fees calculated by dividing the cost
10	identified in section 59604(d) by the total number of hours of applicant use set forth in
11	section 59602(a)(1).
12	(3) If charging for all direct costs, add the hourly rates calculated in subdivisions
13	(a)(1) and (a)(2).
14	(b) A community college district governing board may elect to discount direct cost
15	fees charged based on the type or category of applicant, including, but not limited to,
16	those with tax-exempt status. All such discounts shall be contained in the adopted fee
17	schedule.

21	§ 59606. Expending Capital Fees.
22	Funds collected by a community college district as capital direct costs shall be
23	deposited into a special fund that shall only be used for capital maintenance, repair,
