DEETAC will identify best practices in the development and evaluation of distance education and other instructional offerings utilizing instructional technology and recommend guidelines and regulatory changes.

- Establish DEETAC as an "advise and consult" body for system wide educational technology procurement
- Collaborate with 5C to develop guidelines for competency-based education
- Recommend change for noncredit DE funding
