Established by Board of Governors Standing Order 409, the DEETAC advises the Chancellor's Office on the vision, policy and planning in support of distance education and educational technology. DEETAC's primary goal is improvement in student access and success through instructional technology in the classroom, hybrid courses and distance education. DEETAC will identify best practices in the development and evaluation of distance education and other instructional offerings utilizing instructional technology and recommend guidelines and regulatory changes.

Summary of DEETAC Goals

These goals are not all inclusive and DEETAC reserves the right to amend them at any time. They are in no particular order.

- 1. Explore inclusion of a new MIS data element for Zero Textbook Cost degree programs
- 2. Collaborate with 5C to develop guidelines for competency-based education
- 3. Recommend change for noncredit DE funding
- 4. Develop guidance for DE audit tests for the field
- 5. Establish DEETAC as an "advise and consult" body for system wide educational technology procurement
- 6. Endorse a SARA information event and revisit a letter of support

- 3. Revise the charter
