RE: Formal Notification of Intent to Award for FY21-22 California Apprenticeship Initiative (CAI): New & Innovative [March 2022 Submission]

This memorandum is a formal notification of the intent to award \$19 million for the California Apprenticeship Initiative: New & Innovative March 2022 Submission for the Workforce and Economic Development Division within the Office of Equitable Student Learning, Experience and Impact of the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office. This award will create new opportunities for 1,064 apprentices and 1,950 pre-apprentices between fiscal years 2022-23 and 2025-26.

The California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office, Workforce and Economic Development Division acknowledge the quality of applications and the ability to meet diverse sector needs. Pending Board of Governors' approval, as well as the availability of funds, grant commencement is scheduled for October 1, 2022. The table starting on page 3 is a list of the project applications, the industry sector and regions served by the plan, the number of new apprentices or preapprentices planned to be registered under the plan, and the plan budget. Again, <u>these grants will</u> <u>not be formally awarded until after Board of Governors' approval, and institutions included in this</u> <u>notification should not make public statements indicating the receipt of funding until after Board</u> <u>of Governors' approval.</u>

The grant applications were reviewed and competitively scored. The result is that all applications received high enough scores to qualify for funding, and funding is available to support all applications received. As a result, all applications received sufficient scoring to proceed with Board recommendations to award.

Appeals of the recommendations to award must be received within ten (10) business days from the day this letter is distributed and posted online. Please refer to Section 3470 of the Chancellor's Office' <u>Contracts and Grants Manual</u> for information on filing an appeal. If an appeal is entered during this period, the grants affected will not be awarded, pending Board of Governors' approval, until the appeal is resolved. The appeal must specify the grounds of appeal and must be based on the process and/or procedures used in the review and recommendation of application for awards.

The Chancellor's Office may contact the institution intended to receive funding to request technical changes, including budget and activity changes, to the application work plan prior to completing the execution of the grant agreement. Individual grant commencement dates may be delayed if institutions' do not address any Chancellor's Office requests in a timely manner. A copy of the fully executed grant agreement will be emailed to the institution once fully executed.

For audit purposes, funded institutions must retain a copy of the grant agreement, the request for application (RFA) specifications, and the Workforce and Economic Development Division RFA Instructions, Terms and Conditions for three years. Collectively, these documents constitute the legally binding agreement to perform the specified work.
