RE: Formal Notification of Intent to Award for Perkins Reserve Innovation Grants

This memorandum is a formal notification of the intent to award for Perkins Reserve Innovation Grant by the Workforce and Economic Development Division (WEDD) of the Chancellor's Office.

WEDD acknowledges the quality of applications submitted and proposed activities to meet the Perkins V equity and innovation provisions in alignment with the *Vision for Success* goals. <u>Pending Board of Governor's approval</u>, as well as the availability of funds, grant commencement will be July 25, 2022. These grants will not be formally awarded until after Board of Governors' approval, and institutions included in this notification should not make public statements indicating the receipt of funding until after Board of Governors' approval. A list of the project applications and the funding status can be found in the "Intent to Award" table on page 2.

All applications were reviewed and competitively scored. In accordance with the published Request for Application, the project applications with "Funded with Conditions" status will be conditional awards until applicants can demonstrate the 50% match requirement utilizing Student Equity and Achievement (SEA) funds or other equity funds. All funding sources that aim to reduce local equity and performance gaps are considered equity funds. Applicants can find

more information about categorical funds that support equitable student success in the published Chancellor's Office 2021-22 allocations reports <u>Volume 1</u> and <u>Volume 2</u>. The Chancellor's Office plans to release its 2022-2023 allocations report by August 2022.

Applicants have ten business days from the day this memorandum is distributed and posted online to enter an appeal. If an appeal is entered during this period, the grants affected will not be awarded until the appeal is resolved. The appeal must specify the grounds of appeal and must be based on the process and/or procedures used in the review and recommendation of application for awards.

Before the execution of a grant agreement, Chancellor's Office staff will contact institutions receiving funding to request adjustments or modifications to the proposal and/or budget.
