**RE:** Fiscal Year 2021-22 Reimbursement of Related and Supplemental Instruction Hours

Provided Through Registered Apprenticeship Programs - ReCalc Guidance

This memorandum is to provide information regarding the Fiscal Year 2021-22 reimbursement of Related and Supplemental Instruction (RSI) and the ReCalc process, which is the procedure to review unspent funds and to redistribute those funds.

As part of the FY 2021-22 RSI ReCalc process, all Division of Apprenticeship Standards (DAS) registered apprenticeship programs should report through their Local Education Agency (LEA) partners all their RSI hours in NOVA, whether or not they were allotted to be reimbursed at the start of FY 2021-22. Reporting RSI hours in NOVA will provide the program the opportunity to be reimbursed for that instruction, even if a program was not allotted funding. Additionally, reporting all program hours of instruction will provide the Chancellor's Office an opportunity to submit a request for RSI funding in FY 2023-24 that may allow for more programs to receive RSI reimbursement allocations in that year. If an LEA does not have RSI reporting setup in NOVA, the LEA must email apprenticeship@cccco.edu to request access. Please include in the email a list of all DAS registered programs that will be included in reporting and attach documentation that demonstrates each program's registration.

A memorandum will be distributed in January 2023 announcing the ultimate amounts reimbursed in Fiscal Year 2021-22 per district and the outcomes of Fiscal Year 2021-22 RSI funding.
