What is Direct Assessment (DA) Competency-Based Education (CBE)?

- The **time** it takes to demonstrate competencies *varies*
- Students learn by **engaging in learning exercises**, activities and experiences
- Students receive **proactive guidance and support from faculty and staff**
- Learners earn credentials by **demonstrating mastery** through multiple forms of assessment, often at a personalized pace



Pace+ Program Features

- Student directed pacing means those with **prior experience can move faster**
- **Direct Assessment** means once you pass the formative assessments at 80/90%, you can move on to the final assessment
- **Summative assessments**, many administered VR enabled actors, are graded by a separate faculty member (unbundled model)
- **Books & Materials are no-cost** to students
- Coastline's Pace+ program is **fully online**
- Aligned with industry through **advisory boards**
- **Subscription Based Model**
 - Students pay one fee and complete as much as they can, at their own pace
 - Allows for pauses when life happens
 - Students can continue across terms
- No more waiting months until the semester starts -- **12 starts per year**
