**RE:** Intent to Award Industry Driven Regional Collaborative (IDRC) Grants

The Chancellor's Office is pleased to announce the Intent to Award Industry Driven Regional Collaborative (IDRC) Grants. We appreciate the strong response to this funding opportunity and commend all applicants for their thoughtful and innovative proposals.

The IDRC initiative serves as a catalyst for agile and scalable workforce development solutions. The overarching aim is to fund short-term, performance-oriented projects that prepare learners for future-ready careers while promoting equitable access and economic mobility. Aligned with Education Code Section 88600, this initiative empowers colleges to act swiftly and collaboratively in addressing critical workforce skills gaps and building sustainable partnerships with industry.

#### **Grant Awards**

Outlined in Table 1 are grant awards by region, district, college, and funding status. Before the execution of grant agreements, grant awards must be approved by the California Community Colleges Board of Governors Awards are anticipated to be submitted for approval by the Board of Governors during its September 2025 meeting date.

This was a highly competitive process, with 51 applications received. Following a rigorous review and scoring process, applications were categorized into three groups:

- **Funded (F):** Applications awarded grant funding, pending Board of Governors approval Sept. 17, 2025.
- Passing Score No Funding (PS-NF): Applications that earned a passing score but could not be funded due to limited resources.
- **Not Eligible (NE):** Applications that did not meet the passing score needed to receive an award.

## **Appeals Process**

Applicants may submit a protest by **5 p.m. on Aug. 4, 2025**. Appeals are limited to the grounds that the Chancellor's Office failed to correctly follow the specified processes for reviewing the application. The college/district must email a complete written appeal to the Economic and Workforce Development Vice Chancellor, Anthony Cordova at <u>ACordova@CCCCO.edu</u>, including the issue(s) in dispute, the legal authority or other basis for the position, and the remedy sought.

## **Next Steps**

Following board approval, Economic and Workforce Development (EWD) staff will provide guidance and next steps to the awarded colleges, including instructions for submitting required face pages, project plans and budgets in the NOVA system. Grant agreements must be fully executed before funding can be processed. Funds will be distributed through the established claim process.
