**RE: Report on California Community Colleges Nursing Educational Programs Multicriteria Selection Process for Fiscal Year 2022-23**

Dear Secretary Contreras,

Pursuant to California Education Code section 78261.5, the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office and the Board of Governors for California Community Colleges (Board of Governors) are pleased to release the report on California community colleges nursing educational programs multicriteria selection process for fiscal year 2022-23.

As required by the Education Code, this report includes the participation, retention, and completion rates in community college registered nursing programs for students admitted through a multicriteria screening process, disaggregated by age, gender, ethnicity, and home language.

A review of the data provided by the colleges revealed gaps, such as the lack of information on languages spoken by nursing students. The Chancellor's Office is addressing data interoperability issues that prevent exact counts. This report combines data on students in their final year of nursing training with program-level data to estimate total student populations and demographics.
